Emergency Policy

In the event of an injury to a child in my care, I would first try to contact an appropriate adult to discuss any further action that may be required.

If I cannot contact an appropriate adult and the child requires emergency treatment, I will seek medical advice/treatment from the local hospital/doctors.

In the event of an emergency I will arrange for either my neighbour who is a teaching assistant with two children of her own and is CRB checked to take care of the other children or, should she not be available at that time, I would then contact another available local childminder who is well known to me to take over until I am in a position to resume responsibility.

My insurance covers me to provide alternative care in the event of such an emergency. The above also applies in the event of an emergency involving my own children.
